Supplies

seeds

seed starting mix and potting soil

watering can, spray bottle

heat mat

trays and domes, any container that has drainage, paper pot maker

tags and pencil shop lights soil blocker

Ideal Conditions

microclimate

timing, season and last frost date/first frost date

day length

heat 65°-70°F, for most seeds

humidity, air circulation

water

full spectrum light

thinning

fertilizer

hardening off

transplanting

Potential issues during seed growth

leggy seedlings damping off, mold aphids, fungus gnats

Easiest seeds to start indoors, February through May
